Upon consideration of Defendant's Motion for an Extension, and Plaintiff's Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Opposition thereto, it is hereby ORDERED that the said motion be, and it is hereby, denied; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Defendant shall produce responsive documents to Plaintiff according to the following revised schedule:

a. Defendant shall make its next production of responsive documents to Plaintiff on or before July 21, 2016;

b. Defendant shall make another production of responsive documents to Plaintiff — consisting of approximately one-half of the responsive documents still to be produced — on or before August 8, 2016;

c. Defendant shall complete its production of responsive documents to Plaintiff on or before September 6, 2016;

d. On or before September 14, 2016, Defendant shall provide Plaintiff with a draft *Vaughn* index containing sufficient information to allow Plaintiff to understand the nature of

any documents Defendant has withheld, and stating the FOIA exemption claimed for each withheld document; and

e. Plaintiff shall file a status report with the Court on or before September 23, 2016.
